 - Is it important or core information? ✓ - is the information a solution to the problem? ✓
 - Who said or wrote this? ✓ Is the person credible? ✓
 - How is this the same or different ✓ from something else one read or heard? ✓
 - When was this written or said? ✓ - is the information up to date or could there be newer information? ✓
 - Learners can provide an example for the second part of their response eg Is it a generalisation? - All women are bad drivers.
